

## Filet Fleur-de-lis square

Pattern assumes knowledge of single crochet, double crochet, and chain stitches.

Chart uses 3 dc mesh filet crochet. Each solid square is 3 dc, each open mesh is (dc, ch 1, sk 1, dc) . Design is symmetrical so you don't have to worry about reading right to left or left to right.

Materials: You can use any hook and any yarn for this pattern

Size: Will depend on yarn and hook used

Instructions: Work a foundation chain of 49 and follow chart using double crochet. White blocks are open. Grey blocks are closed. When complete, work a single crochet edging all around in same or contrast color.
